## 1 Usage

Historically, the `Grey` template was used **to color text** in pages, with the "classic MediaWiki grey" color. It is now mapped on the `STDarkGrey` template that is a STMicroelectronics corporate color.

```
Usage:  {{Grey|<text to color>}}
```

Where `<text to color>` is the text to format in grey. If this template is called with no text, the hexadecimal code of the color is returned.

### Warning

Do not use this template anymore: use the `STDarkGrey` template instead.



## 2 Basic examples

You type	You get

### 3 More examples

<p>Grey and bold</p> <pre>This was a <b>{{Grey '"classic MediaWiki"'}}</b> color: <b>'{{Grey grey: ■}}'</b>: it is now mapped on the ST dark grey.</pre>	<p>This was a "classic MediaWiki" color: <b>grey</b>: : it is now mapped on the ST dark grey.</p>
<p>Grey and italic</p> <pre>This was a <i>{{Grey '"classic MediaWiki"'}}</i> color: <i>'{{Grey grey: ■}}'</i>: it is now mapped on the ST dark grey.</pre>	<p>This was a "<i>classic MediaWiki</i>" color: <i>grey</i>: : it is now mapped on the ST dark grey.</p>

## 1 Usage

The STDarkGrey template is used to color text in pages, with the STMicroelectronics corporate primary color shade of dark grey ().

```
Usage:  {{STDarkGrey|<text to color>|tint=<tint>}}
```

Where:

- **<text to color>** is the text to format in dark grey. If this template is called with no text, the hexadecimal code of the color is returned.
- **<tint>** is the tint of the color expressed in percentage. If tint is not set then the original color is used (tint = 100%). The possible value are:
  - **75**: 75% of the original color tint
  - **50**: 50% of the original color tint
  - **25**: 25% of the original color tint

Coloring text in 50% tint of dark grey <pre>This is a {{STDarkGrey STMicroelectronics corporate color: 50% tint of dark grey: ■   tint=50}}</pre>	This is a STMicroelectronics corporate color: 50% tint of dark grey:
Coloring text in 25% tint of dark grey <pre>This is a {{STDarkGrey STMicroelectronics corporate color: 25% tint of dark grey: ■   tint=25}}</pre>	This is a STMicroelectronics corporate color: 25% tint of dark grey:
Getting the hexadecimal code of the color <pre>{{STDarkGrey}}</pre> is the hexadecimal code of STMicroelectronics dark grey.	#464650 is the hexadecimal code of STMicroelectronics dark grey.
Getting the hexadecimal code of the 75% tint of the color <pre>{{STDarkGrey   tint=75}}</pre> is the hexadecimal code of STMicroelectronics 75% tint of dark grey.	#74747C is the hexadecimal code of STMicroelectronics 75% tint of dark grey.



You type	You get
<p>Getting the hexadecimal code of the 50% tint of the color</p> <pre>code block: {{STDarkGrey   tint=50}} is the hexadecimal code of STMicroelectronics 50% tint of dark grey.</pre>	<p>#A2A2A7 is the hexadecimal code of STMicroelectronics 50% tint of dark grey.</p>
<p>Getting the hexadecimal code of the 25% tint of the color</p> <pre>code block: {{STDarkGrey   tint=25}} is the hexadecimal code of STMicroelectronics 25% tint of dark grey.</pre>	<p>#D1D1D3 is the hexadecimal code of STMicroelectronics 25% tint of dark grey.</p>



### 3 More examples

You type	You get
<p>dark grey and bold</p> <pre>This is a {{STDarkGrey 'STMicroelectronics'}} corporate color: '{{STDarkGrey shade of dark grey: ■}}'</pre>	<p>This is a <b>STMicroelectronics</b> corporate color: <b>shade of dark grey:</b></p>
<p>dark grey and italic</p> <pre>This is a {{STDarkGrey 'STMicroelectronics'}} corporate color: '{{STDarkGrey shade of dark grey: ■}}'</pre>	<p>This is a <i>STMicroelectronics</i> corporate color: <i>shade of dark grey:</i></p>
