1 Usage

The STDarkGreen template is used **to color text** in pages, with the STMicroelectronics brand secondary color **shade of dark green** ().

```
Usage:  {{STDarkGreen|<text to color>}}
```

Where **<text to color>** is the text to format in dark green. If this template is called with no text, the hexadecimal code of the color is returned.
